



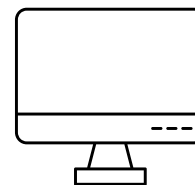
RESPONDENT ACCESS

User Registration Instructions

Signing up for Respondent Access Portal lets you see information about your immigration case. You can also file documents online instead of having to do it at court. The immigration court will let you know if you are allowed to register.

STEP 1: Sign up online

Go to <https://ereg.eoir.justice.gov/register> and apply as “Respondent.” Fill out some information about yourself, like your name, A-number, and birthday. Once you’ve entered everything, you click submit, and they’ll send you an email to say they got your request.



STEP 2: Show who you are



After that, you have to go to immigration court to prove that you are who you say you are. You’ll need to bring identification like a passport, U.S. driver’s license, or work authorization card. If you don’t have those, you can bring other things like a school ID with a bill that has your name on it. ([Check identity document requirements here.](#)) You have to do this part within 90 days, which is about three months. If you don’t, you’ll have to start over.

STEP 3: Activate your account

Once they know it’s really you, they’ll send you another email from noreply@okta.gov with instructions on how to finish setting up your account. After that, you’ll be all set and can log in to the portal using the email address you signed up with.
