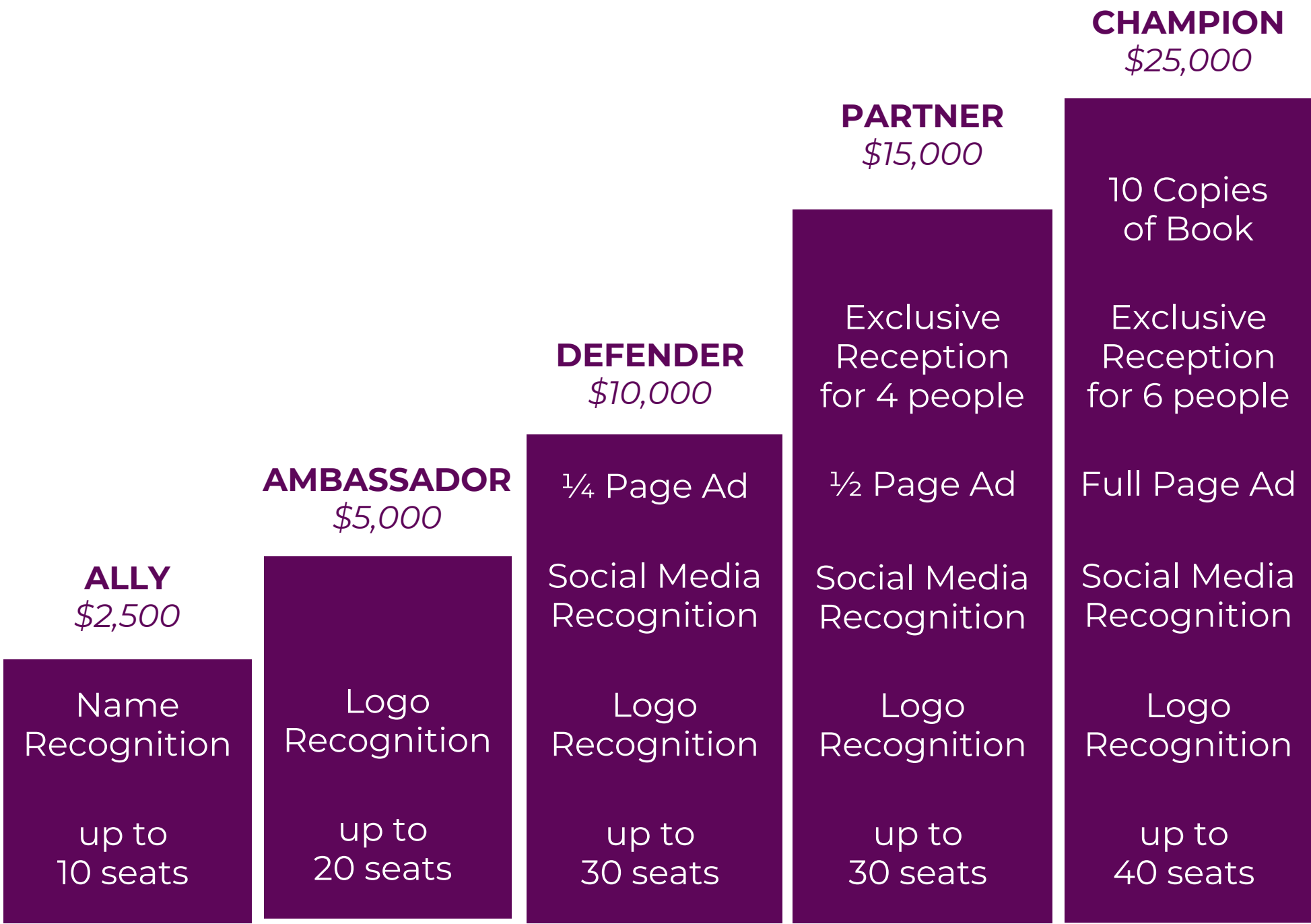

We provide a lifeline to asylum seekers, unaccompanied children, and trafficking victims, **supporting thousands of volunteer attorneys to provide legal representation.** In Minnesota, unrepresented immigrants are 3x more likely to be deported.

Together we monitor Hennepin County court cases involving gender-based violence, **advocating for a trauma-informed criminal justice system** that works for all survivors.

We **partner with human rights defenders around the world**, helping them achieve their goals of abolishing the death penalty, protecting LGBTQ+ people, and combating violence against women.

We **empower children at the Sankhu Palubari Community School** in rural Kathmandu Valley in Nepal through high-quality, free pre-k to 10th grade education.
