- 3. Copy of Marriage Certificate with English translation, if needed;
- 4. Divorce Decree with English translation, if any;
- 5. Residential history for the last 5 years, include dates (beginning with current address);
- 6. Employment history for the last 5 years, include dates, occupation, addresses;
- 7. Full name of parents, date of births, place of births, current city and country of residency;
- 8. Full name of all children; date of births, place of births, current city and country of residency;
- 9. Last residential address in your home country;
- 10. Last employment occupation in your home country;
- 11. Medical Exams, please visit the immigration website and type your current zip code for a list of doctors near your area: https://www.uscis.gov/greencard/medical-exam-find-a-doctor (do not get them done until you are near ready to submit the application, they are only valid for 60 days);
- 12. 8 Passport Photos (please take a picture with your phone 2"x2 against a white wall and send them to us via email, we will print the 8 passport photos). The photos should have a neutral expression, no smiling or smirks).
- 13. Immigration fees are \$1,760. They can be paid in money order, cashier check, or personal check; payable to U.S. Department of Homeland Security; (This is not needed right now, please bring the fees when coming to sign the forms)

Petitioner/Child:

- 1. Copy of Naturalization Certificate;
- 2. U.S. Passport;
- 3. Complete Tax Return for last 3 years with all W-2s (please obtain original transcripts from IRS directly)
- 4. 2 Passport photos (<u>please take a picture with your phone 2"x2 against a white wall and send them to us via email, we will print the 2 passport photos</u>). The photos should have a neutral expression, no smiling or smirks).
- 5. Residential history for the last 5 years, include dates;
- 6. Employment history for the last 5 years, include dates, occupation, addresses;
- 7. Email
- 8. Cell phone number.
- 9. If a joint sponsor is required, this individual must be a Legal Permanent Resident or a US. Citizen. The following is required from the joint sponsor:
 - Copy of greencard, US passport, Naturalization Certificate, or US birth certificate,
 - Complete copy of latest Tax Return from 2019 with W-2s or I-9s,
 - Current employer's information and current occupation,
 - Cell phone and email.
