- 4. moved to Sioux Falls October 13, 2018 to live with Petitioner in an effort to escape the long history of abuse and neglect she suffered in Guatemala.
- 5. Petitioner was ten (10) or eleven (11), over fifteen (15) years ago. The family understood that their father left with another woman and neither nor Petitioner have heard from since then. Petitioner has no address for and has no way to contact him.
- 7. After size is mother passed away, there was only one person who agreed to care for size, size is size is she used to be Petitioner's mother's friend.
- 8. Education has always been important to to care for and pay for her to go to school. Began living with to care for and pay for her to go to school. Began living with attended school during her first two years of living there. When she was about 8 years old, forced her to begin working in the family's cantina. Stopped attending school to do so. She described her role in the cantina as "like a servant." worked long days, from about 4:00 am to 9:00 pm. her husband, and her children would beat to make her work. They used their hands, cables, and belts to hit her on her back, arms, and feet, often leaving bruises. They would also withhold food. This happened almost every day from when she was about 8 years old until she fled when she was 14 years old.

suffered abuse and neglect as a result of lacking any parent who would care for and supervise her. Reunification with "s mother is not viable due to death, a similar basis to abuse, neglect, or abandonment because "s mother died on June 10, 2010.

- 20. Pursuant to SDCL § 29A-5-208, Petitioner requests findings of fact and conclusions of law for his appointment as guardian. Petitioner requests the court make special findings laid out in sections 17-19 herein as well as an order for guardianship. Petitioner will provide a proposed order and findings of fact and conclusions of law for the Court's convenience at the hearing on this matter.
- 21. Appointing Petitioner as guardian for is proper for all of the reasons set forth in this Petitioner, including but not limited to the following:
 - a) Petitioner provides for and has provided a stable home for to live without fear of physical and emotional abuse.

- b) Petitioner agreed to take reasonable steps to acquire legal guardianship or custody in the Office of Refugee Resettlement agreement with the US Department of Health and Human Services.
- c) In order for to get a passport for identification, the Guatemalan Consulates will require signed parental consent of both parents to get a passport for minors unless she obtains a court order for guardianship.
- was abandoned by her father, left behind due to her mother's death, and abused and neglected by her former caretakers. She is alone in a new country and needs a stable guardian who can protect her from abuse, abandonment, and neglect.
- e) Petitioner would be able to provide medical insurance and healthcare for
- f) Petitioner would be able to provide financial aid for college.
- g) as a minor over the age of fourteen, desires to nominate Petitioner as permanent guardian pursuant to SDCL § 29A-5-202.
- h) As a matter of South Dakota law, Petitioner believes that South Dakota would find that this guardianship petition is in the best interest of pursuant to SDCL § 29A-5-201-210 (the minor statutes) in this situation, namely one in which she does not speak English fluently, is still enrolled in high school, will likely be subjected to further abuse and abandonment in Guatemala, and is dependent on Petitioner.

WHEREFORE, the Petitioner requests the Court set a time and place for hearing; notice be given as provided by law; the Court issue an Order granting guardianship in favor of granting; and letters of Guardianship be issued without bond.
